

Rushford-Peterson Valley (RPV) Pageant Scholarship Rules

The RPV Pageant Committee, along with the Rushford Days Committee, has set up the following rules and/or guidelines to govern the distribution of the scholarship money.

- \$1,400 has been designated as a higher education scholarship. This means it must be used for educational related expenses.
- \$500 will be awarded to the Queen, \$400 will be awarded to the 1st Attendant, \$300 will be awarded to the 2nd Attendant, and \$200 will be awarded to the 3rd Attendant.
- This money will be awarded to the Queen and Attendants only. If, for some reason, they cannot fulfill the requirements set by the committee, or they choose not to continue their education at a post-secondary school, the money will be reinvested for future Pageant Scholarships.
- The scholarship money will be awarded after two (2) quarters or one (1) semester of post-secondary education or enrollment in a military program. It also must be used within one year of graduating from high school.
- A copy of a report card, with a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or above, from the previous quarter/semester must be provided in order to receive scholarship monies.
- Scholarship monies/checks will be made out to both the educational institution and the winner.
- If any winner fails to fulfill all the obligations or requirements of being on the Queen Court, part of or all scholarship monies may be forfeited and reinvested for future scholarships.
- A copy of these scholarship rules/guidelines will be placed on file with the Rushford Days Committee. A member of the RPV Queen Committee and a member of the Rushford Days Committee will review all documents associated with the scholarship before any money will be awarded.
